Please note! It is very important that school has the most up to date contact details of your telephone numbers as we come to the end of our school year. ## Healthy Choices - a polite reminder!

We continue to be proud of our Platinum Healthy School Award. Please support your children to make healthy choices for break times and at lunchtimes in their lunch boxes. #### AIP Catering

Free School Meals and KS1 Universal Free School Meals children - please note! If your child is a Free School Meal child or is in EYFS or KS1 they are entitled to a free school lunch which would be a hot meal from the school canteen. If your child is moving in KS2 in September and your child is Free school meals /pupil premium there is NO cost for their lunch.

If you are NOT receiving Free school meals / Pupil premium and you want your child to receive a hot lunch, there will be a cost of £ 2:30 per meal per day if your child is years 3,4,5 or 6. Please book lunches online on SCHOOL FOOD UNITED TO BOOK YOUR CHILD'S PREFERRED LUNCH OPTION. You can access your account online to

If you would rather send your child in with their own packed lunch you are welcome to do so (please remember no nuts (including Nutella), tomatoes or oranges as we have children with severe allergies in school.

#### Attendance

Any absence affects the pattern of a child's schooling and regular absence will seriously affect their learning. Please ensure that you endeavour to get your child to school and in on time for 8:50 am. The playground gates open at 8:40am and the official start to the school day is 8:50 am. If your child arrives to school after the registers close, they will receive a late mark that is recorded on your child's attendance record. If your child is ill and is unable to come to school, please contact the school office on 0121 558 1643 and leave a message or speak to Mrs Slater.

Please remember that taking holidays in term time will affect your child's schooling and we ask for your co-operation to not take your child away in school time as this will be UNAUTHORISED.
